The New Teacher Institute was developed to provide support to all teachers new to the Cobb County School District. The Institute is held for four consecutive days in the summer. The purpose of the Institute is to provide a focus on the effective teaching standards in the classroom environment, planning and preparation, instruction and professional responsibilities as reflected in the CLASS Keys. You will receive valuable resources and support to make your teaching experience successful for you and your students. The July 31st session is highly recommended and a \$100 stipend will be paid to participants. The August 1 – 3, 2012 sessions are required and part of the teaching contract. Participants will also receive 3 Professional Learning Units of credit for completion of all four days.

All new teachers should arrive at Durham by 8:00 for opening sessions on both July 31st and August 1st. Elementary teachers will transition to Frey Elementary School which shares a parking lot with Durham after the opening sessions. Dress for the Institute is business casual. No registration is required as your participation is expected. The Institute is considered your job site for these dates.
