Overall Rating Criteria	
Distinguished	Use an overall rating of Distinguished when there is a Distinguished rating in two or more of the domains, with the remaining domains rated as Proficient.
Proficient	Use an overall rating of Proficient when there is no more than one domain rated Basic with the remaining domains rated as Proficient or higher.
Basic	Use an overall rating of Basic when there is more than one domain rated as Basic with the remaining domains rated as Proficient or higher.
Unsatisfactory	Use an overall rating of Unsatisfactory when any domain receives a rating of Unsatisfactory.
