**NOTE:** Supplemental funding from Proposition 301 (Classroom Site Fund) and Proposition 202 (Instructional Improvement Fund) accounts for 4.90% of the salary amount in each cell. This may result in an annual fluctuation of the supplemental salary amount in each cell. The revenue that the District receives from these two funds is based on state sales tax revenue, state land trust sales, and gaming proceeds which fluctuate each year.

The breakdown for 2010-11 is indicated in italics below each salary line on the schedule.

The Governing Board has approved two furlough days for the 2010-11 year. The reduction is not reflected on the salary schedule.
