#### US Public School Teaching Experience

- 1.5% above the starting teacher salary for each two years of creditable experience for a maximum of 15%

#### Non-Public School Teaching Experience

- 1.0% above the starting teacher salary for each two years of creditable experience for a maximum of 10%
- Non-Public School experience Includes: U.S. Private School or Charter School with documentary evidence of appropriate state certification
- Foreign Public School or Private School with proof from the accrediting agency in that foreign country
- Each two years of full-time industry aligned work experience

#### Retired Teachers

Retired teachers who have been separated from M-DCPS may return at their previously held salary or have all eligible years of experience reviewed and placed according to the above criteria if separated for more than one calendar year

#### Retired Teachers

- Retired teachers from any Public School or Private School will have all eligible years of experience reviewed up to a maximum of 15% above the starting teacher salary
