A Student Learning Objective (SLO) is a content area grade or course-specific measurable learning objective that can be used to document student learning over a defined period of time. In essence, learning goals are established for students, their progress is monitored toward these goals, and then the degree to which educators help students achieve these goals is evaluated. The three parts of the SLO are:

- Learning Goals
- Assessments
- Targets

SLOs are a measure of student growth. It is state-mandated that SLOs are implemented beginning with the 2015-16 school year. SLOs are designed to strengthen teaching and improve student learning.

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
